Karen Guinand | 54 years old | Freelance financial analyst | Deputy mayor, member of the committee of the Association des Communes Genevoises, president of the social commission of the Groupement des Communes de la Rive Droite du Lac, member of the committee of the Association Transfrontalière des Communes Riveraines de l'Aéroport

Born in Geneva, mother of three children aged 19 to 22, she has lived in Genthod since 2000.

She holds a Bachelor's degree in economics from Cambridge University and a Master's degree in finance from Geneva. She began her career in auditing and then worked for a major private bank for almost 20 years. Promoted Director in 2008, her skills in financial analysis and team management were widely recognised.

Since 2014, she has worked as a freelance financial analyst and writer, giving her time to serve first the Genthod School Parents' Association, which she chaired from 2014 to 2018, and then the commune.

She served on the Municipal Council from 2017 to 2020, before being elected Deputy Mayor in 2020. She has put a lot of energy and discipline into this function, carrying out major projects in the social and planning arenas. Her motivation to continue her commitment to the benefit of the Genthod residents is as strong as ever.

Involved in several inter-municipal groups and committees, she has developed important links with the executive authorities of other municipalities, particularly neighbouring ones, enabling shared management of certain matters, an exchange of best practices and a joint approach to broader issues, such as the airport impacts (noise and financial) or early childhood care.

Bastien Guex | 44 years old | Biologist, Scientific assistant | Former president of the local council, member of the committee of the Genthod-Bellevue gymnastics society

Born in Geneva, married with a son, he has lived in Genthod since 1987.

He holds a Master's degree in science, and has been working as Assistant Scientist at the Cantonal Environment Office since 2012.

He spent several years with an engineering firm in the fields of environmental impact and pollutants. His current role involves soil and groundwater protection within interdisciplinary projects. Active at the heart of the canton's major issues, he knows how to collaborate with all of a municipality's partners.

He has served on the Municipal Council for 13 years and is currently its secretary, having chaired it on a couple of occasions. He has headed the Environmental commission for the past two terms, and is a member of the Planning & Mobility commission and the Buildings & Public Works commission. His years in politics have enabled him to participate in all commissions, outside of the Safety one. This gives him a comprehensive view of the functioning of the municipality. His commitment naturally brings him to offer to put his time, his experience, both private and public, and his professional network to the benefit of the Administrative Council.
